Volunteers in the Park

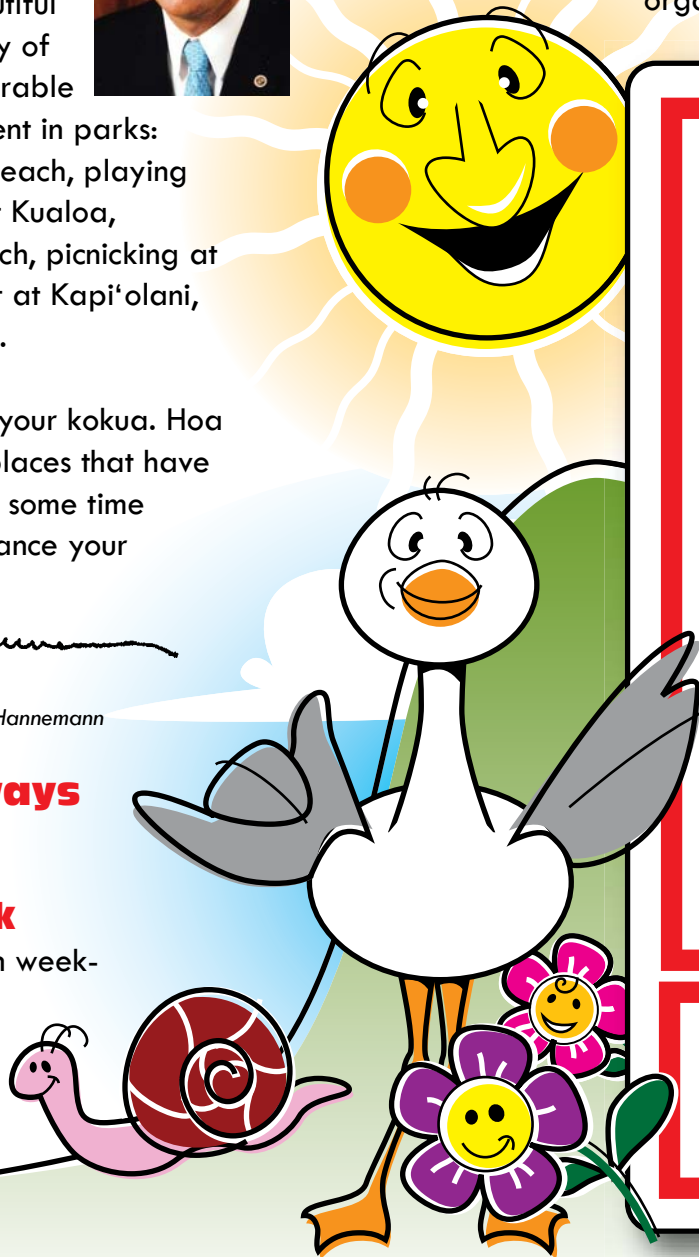
Item	Approximate Cost

Park benches	\$ 3,000
Picnic Tables	\$ 4,000
Exercise Station	\$ 75,000
Play Apparatus	\$ 100,000

The highest level of public-private partnership is the Ali‘i Park Partner program. Ali‘i Park partners regularly participate in the maintenance and upkeep of a park for a minimum of ten (10) years or make a monetary donation to a park of \$10,000 or other substantial donation.
