# PERMITS

**A**loha Camper, permits are required to camp at all City and County of Honolulu parks. Permits may be obtained online at <https://camping.honolulu.gov/> or in person at the Fasi Municipal Building (FMB). Online permits become available two (2) Fridays before the Friday you wish to camp at 5:00pm HST. In person permits become available the following Monday in the Permits Office. Vehicle information is also needed while obtaining a permit.

Camping begins on Friday and extends through the weekend ending on either Monday at 8am (3 days) or Wednesday at 8am (5 days). Permits cost \$32 for a 3-day site and \$52 for a 5-day site. Applicant must be at least 18 years old and are allowed one permit per weekend. A camping permit allows for a maximum of ten (10) people and two (2) tents.

There is no camping in any City and County of Honolulu park on Wednesdays or Thursdays.

Permits Office hours are from 8:00am-4:00pm Monday – Friday. We are closed Saturdays, Sundays and State holidays.

## City and County of Honolulu GENERAL CAMPING RULES

Aloha, please have your permit available at all times for inspection. Below are general camping rules that apply at all City & County parks. A complete list of rules can be found at <https://camping.honolulu.gov>. Violations of these rules may result in a fine of up to \$500 and/or revocation of your camping permit.

1. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED.**
2. Each permit allows for a maximum of 10 people, 3 vehicles and 2 tents. Maximum tent size is 15x11 feet.
3. Please keep camping area clear of all rubbish at all times.
4. Campfires are prohibited except in fire pits and campfire rings provided by the City and County. Charcoal fires are allowed in grills and braziers for cooking purposes. Stoves and braziers must be at least 12 inches off the ground and kept away from trees and plants.
5. Vehicles must have a vehicle permit displayed on the dash. (except Hau'ula)
6. Use of the Department's electricity for lights, appliances, etc, or hookup for water in connection with camping is prohibited.
7. Do not wash dishes or equipment in shower rooms or open shower areas.
8. No driving or parking on the grass.
9. Nails, screws, or spikes shall not be driven into trees, plants, or structures.
10. Waterslides and inflatable bouncers are prohibited at all campgrounds.
11. There are no changes or cancellations once a permit is issued.
